SETTING UP AN OFFICE IN INDIA





The Reserve Bank of India (the "*RBI*"), on March 31, 2016, has notified the Foreign Exchange Management (Establishment of a Branch office or a liaison office or a Project office or any other place of business) Regulations, 2016 (the "*New Regulations*") in India which replace the existing Foreign Exchange Management (Establishment of a Branch office or a liaison office or a Project office or any other place of business) Regulations, 2000 (the "*Old Regulations*").

A comparative analysis of the Old Regulations *vis-a-vis* the New Regulations have been highlighted below:
